



# Rabbit Hat

**SIZES:** Child - 18" head circumference.  
Youth/Small Adult - 20" head circumference.  
Med/Large Adult - 22" head circumference.

**MATERIALS:**

- 2 balls PolarKnit™ Worsted 80m/88yds (1 ball MC, 1 ball CC)
- 5.5mm / US9 short circular and double pointed needles
- 6mm / US10 short circular and double pointed needles
- Stitch markers
- Darning needle
- Pom-pom maker

**GAUGE:** 16sts x 24 rows = 4" (10cm) over stocking stitch (st st). 4.5sts per inch.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

This Rabbit Hat is knit in the round with stocking stitch and has three graphic rabbits around the circumference of the hat.

Using 5.5mm/US9 needles cast on 70 (80, 90)sts. Join into a round being careful not to twist your stitches. Place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of your row. Begin a rib pattern of \*K3, P2\* and repeat for 5 rows.

Change to 6mm/US10 needle and knit one row. While knitting this row increase by 2 (1, 3)sts. You will now have 72 (81, 93)sts.

Begin the Rabbit Graph pattern. Be careful to start in the right place for each respective sized hat.

Continue knitting in st st after each graph pattern is finished until the hat measures 6" (7", 8.5") from the cast on edge.
