



Worsted Winter Ripple Hats

- Sizes:**
- (A) Slouch Style - fits 20-23 inch adult head circumference. Great for people that like a looser fitting hat that resembles a “beret” shape.
 - (B) Adult Hat - fits 20-22 inch adult head circumference. Great for a woman’s head. If you want this style to fit a man’s head, increase needle size to 6.5mm or 7mm (US 10½ or 10¾).
 - (C) Toddler/Child Hat - fits 16-18 inch head circumference.

- Materials:**
- (A) 2 balls PolarKnit™ 80m/88yds - Worsted Weight
 - (B) 1 balls PolarKnit™ 80m/88yds - Worsted Weight
 - (C) 1 ball PolarKnit™ 80m/88yds - Worsted Weight
- 5.5mm (US 9) short circular needle
6mm (US 10) short circular needle
6mm (US 10) double pointed needles
Darning needle
Stitch marker

Gauge: 16 sts and 24 rows = 10 cm (4 inches) - 4sts per inch.

Stitch Abbreviations:

- C6B = Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle (cn) and leave at back of work, k3, then k3 from cn.
- C6F = Slip next 3 sts onto cable needle (cn) and leave at front of work, k3, then k3 from cn.
- Kfb = knit into the front and then the back of one stitch. (Increase)

Cable Pattern:

- Row 1 - Knit.
- Row 2 - Knit.
- Row 3 - K1, *C6B, K6* repeat to end of row.
- Row 4 - Knit.
- Row 5 - Knit.
- Row 6 - Knit.
- Row 7 - K1, *K6, C6F* repeat to end of row.
- Row 8 - Knit.

Instructions:

Beginning with a 5.5mm circular needle cast on (A) 80sts, (B) 80sts, (C) 68sts. Join into round being careful not to twist stitches. Place a stitch marker to remind you where the beginning of the row is. Continue in a *K1, P1* rib pattern for (A) 6 rows, (B and C) 4 rows.

(A) Slouch Hat:

Your next row will be an increase row - *Kfb, P1*repeat to end of row. (120sts)

Change to 6mm circular needles and begin Cable Pattern (consisting of 8 rows). Repeat the Cable Pattern 3 times and then rows 1 to 7 of the pattern again.

Decrease Crown:

Row 1 - *K4, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (100sts)

Row 2 - Knit.

Row 3 - *K3, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (80sts)

Row 4 - *C4B, K4* repeat to end of row.

Row 5 - *K2tog, K2* repeat to end of row. (60sts)

Row 6 - *K1, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (40sts)

Row 7 - *K2tog* repeat to end of row. (20sts) Change to dpn's if necessary.

Row 8 - *K2tog*. (10sts)

Row 9 - *K2tog*. (5sts)

(B) Adult Hat:

Increase by 16sts evenly around your next row while still maintaining rib pattern. (96sts)

Change to 6mm circular needles and begin Cable Pattern (consisting of 8 rows). Repeat the Cable Pattern 3 times and then rows 1 to 4 of the pattern again.

Decrease Crown:

Row 1 - *K6, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (84sts)

Row 2 - *K5, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (72sts)

Row 3 - *K4, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (60sts)

Row 4 - Knit.

Row 5 - *K1, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (40sts)

Row 6 - *K2tog* repeat to end of row. (20sts) Change to dpn's if necessary.

Row 7 - *K2tog*. (10sts)

Row 8 - *K2tog*. (5sts)

(C) Child Hat:

Increase by 16sts evenly around your next row while still maintaining rib pattern. (84sts)

Change to 6mm circular needles and begin Cable Pattern (consisting of 8 rows). Repeat the Cable Pattern 3 times and then rows 1 to 4 of the pattern again.

Decrease Crown:

Row 1 - *K2tog, K4* repeat to end of row. (70sts)

Row 2 - Knit.

Row 3 - *K2tog, K2, C6F* repeat to end of row. (63sts)

Row 4 - Knit.

Row 5 - *K5, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (54sts)

Row 6 - Knit.

Row 7 - *K4, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (45sts)

Row 8 - Knit.

Row 9 - *K3, K2tog* repeat to end of row. (36sts) Change to dpn's if necessary.

Row 10 - *K2tog* repeat to end of row. (18sts)

Row 11 - *K2tog* repeat to end of row.

Break yarn and thread through remaining stitches. Draw tightly and secure.

Always machine wash and dry your finished garment to rid it of residual fluff.
